Message from Victor Childs to the Shareholders of McLaren Resources Inc.

Mr. Liddy's news release of March 03, 2009 has falsely characterized the issues surrounding the notes to the Financial Statements of the Company.

In December 2008, the independent directors became aware of the issue of a possible contingent liability to an Indonesian company under its agreement with McLaren. We then requested that the note disclosure in the financial statements be modified by removing draft wording that stated that there was no liability. Such a statement would be false and misleading. Management refused to make appropriate changes and insisted that the misleading wording remain in place.

McLaren does not have a contingent liability to Batavia Energy, as is falsely stated in Mr. Liddy's news release. Mr. Meredith is not a director or officer of Batavia Energy, which was also falsely stated in Mr. Liddy's news release. The independent directors did not request anything other than proper disclosure in the financial statements by seeking the removal of the misleading wording in the note disclosure.

The shares of the Company would still be trading had Mr. Liddy made an application to the Ontario Securities Commission for a Management Cease Trade Order as approved and directed by the Board of Directors. Under a Management Cease Trade Order only the company management and insiders are subject to a cease trade order, with the shares continuing to trade for the benefit of the public shareholders. Mr. Liddy failed to make the application to the Ontario Securities Commission and the shares were cease traded as a result of his management failure.
